

**Call for applications for the Pannonia Scholarship Programme for the academic year
2024-2025, spring semester
Long-term mobility for studies**

Deadline for submission of applications: **24 October 23:59.**

I. Aim of the Programme

Under the programme, students have the opportunity to participate in mobility abroad in institutions with which the Hungarian University of Sports Science has a prior bilateral agreement. The programme offers the opportunity to gain educational, linguistic and cultural experience at a higher education institution in another programme country. Learning mobility helps the student to progress in his/her studies and develop his/her personal skills.

This option is not available to students participating in the University's Stipendium Hungaricum programme.

Duration of the long-term mobility for studies: 1 semester

II. Eligibility criteria

- You are studying towards a degree at the institution and must be an active student during your mobility.
- Full-time or part-time student
- Eligibility for institutional assessment
- You must have completed at least one semester at the time of application, except for students enrolled in Master's, PhD and doctoral programmes.
- At the end of the mobility period, the host institution abroad must issue a Certificate of Study Period/Transcript of Records.
- In the case of long-term learning mobility, at least 15 ECTS credits must be completed at the host institution.
- The University must fully accept the activities undertaken, completed and certified in the Learning Agreement.

If a student successfully applies twice in consecutive semesters and withdraws his/her application both times after being nominated, he/she can only reapply after missing one application cycle.

IV. Application documents

- Completed and signed application form: you can indicate up to 2 institutions by preference. The order cannot be changed after the application has been submitted.
- CV in English
- Study plan/Letter of motivation, in English. The document must contain the following elements:
 - Why are you applying for the semester?
 - Why are you applying to the institution indicated on the application form? Please indicate the order and all the institutions indicated.
 - What subjects, methodology, facilities have you been interested in at the institution abroad? Why?
 - What are your professional expectations from your semester at Pannonia?
 - What would you like to return from your semester abroad with?
- A certificate of "Average" for the last two semesters downloaded from Neptun or issued by the Office of Academic Affairs
- A copy of a language certificate or, in the absence of a language certificate, a certificate of language proficiency issued by the Language Proficiency Office (no more than 1 year old) (without a certificate, we cannot give credit for the category in question!)

Mobility applications are assessed on the basis of a scoring system established by the University.

Universities that are included in the QS World University Rankings and THE (Times Higher Education) rankings will be given priority in the selection process.

At the end of the mobility, the participant will be required to submit a report with photos, providing detailed information about the studies undertaken during the mobility and agreeing to have their report published on the University's website.
